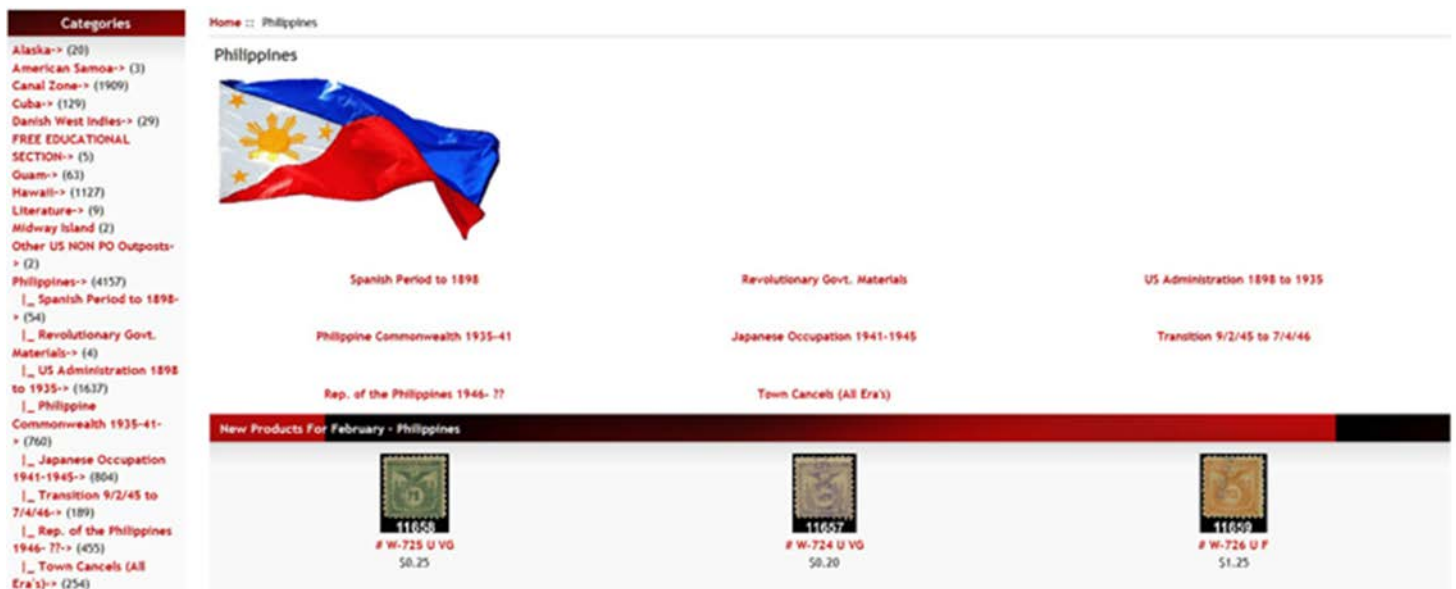

We have modified its original intent of Zen Cart to make it both a source of information as well as selling site. Let us show you step by step how to use it.

Step 1: (To view the store, you can skip this. We advise you to take a moment and click on the **log yourself in** link. It's a one time ordeal, that will open all parts of the site to you. Should you want to order any items, you won't have to spend time later to fill out the forms. It opens the shopping cart for your use, registers you for update notices, and special offers, etc.)

Step 2: Choose a category you wish to view. For the purpose of this demo, we want to view Philippine covers. So, click on Philippines in the Category or Top frame links. This opens to:



Note that under the flag in the center and under Philippines on the Left frame you now see sub-categories. Each Sub category will open to display other sub categories until you reach a final product or item destination. I now decide that I want to see covers from the Town of Legaspi, Albay. So I click on **town cancels, all era's**.

Which takes me to a listing of provinces:

Albay Province



Population Based on the August 2007 census, Albay has a total population of 1,190,823, which makes it the 20th most populous province in the country. There are 208,640 households in the province with an average size of 5.22 persons, significantly higher than the national average of 4.99. Languages Bikol is the primary language spoken in Albay, being a part of the Bicol Region. There are other dialects spoken in the province, however, such as Bicolano Viejo, Daragueño, Legazpeño or Albayanon, Oasnon and others. The dialects spoken in the coastal areas of the province are similar to that spoken in Camarines Sur while those further inland are similar to each other but differs significantly from the coastal dialect. Majority of the inhabitants also understand Tagalog and English. Albay was reorganized as a province under American rule with the passage of Act No. 122 of the Philippine Commission on April 20, 1901. Albay has a total land area of 2,552.6 square kilometers, which makes it the 26th smallest province. Most of Albay is located on mainland Bicol Peninsula and it has four major islands to the east: Rapu-Rapu, Batan (part of Rapu-Rapu), Cagraray (largely part of Bacacay, with small area as part of Mallipot), and San Miguel (part of Tabaco City). Lagonoy Gulf borders the province to the northeast, separating it from the province of Catanduanes. Burias Island in the province Masbate can be found to the southwest across Burias Pass. The province is generally mountainous with scattered fertile plains and valleys. Mayon Volcano, standing at around 2460 meters, is the most famous landmark in Albay, and in the whole of Bicol, in fact. This active volcano is nearly perfectly-shaped and is considered by many to be more beautiful than Mt. Fuji in Japan

This is where the information starts. In the upper frame we have: A map showing the location of Albay Province, and some history of the province, with two cities in red under the history. Since I am looking for Legaspi, I click on Legaspi. This bring up:

A map showing the location of Legaspi at the top of the center frame. We have reached the location where our covers are located for this subject. (no further links under the history). On the bottom frame we see thumbnail pictures with clickable links. (These will bring us items below. (I will click on the bottom cover.) (Note shopping cart now shows on the right.)







Legaspi first became a city under the Becerra Law of 1912. It constituted the municipalities of Legaspi, Albay Nuevo, and Daraga into the Ayuntamiento de Albay. The first set of officials – Alcalde, Teniente de Alcalde, Síndico, Secretario and Regidores (councilor) – took office in 1898. With the American occupation in 1900, the city was dissolved. Upon restoration of peace, the three towns were re-established and in 1908 became the municipality of Albay, the provincial capital of Albay. In 1922, the town of Daraga was separated from the capital. Legaspi became a city for the second time on July 18, 1948 when Daraga and Legaspi were combined to constitute its territory under Republic Act No. 306. With the re-creation of the two municipalities, the city was dissolved on June 8, 1954. Finally, on June 12, 1959, Legaspi became a city for the third time under R.A. 2234. Amendments were introduced under R.A. 5525. Presidential Decree 125 issued on February 23, 1973 declared the town of Daraga as part of the territorial jurisdiction of the city. This decree, however, was not implemented with the onset of the Integrated Reorganization Plan, which involved the restructuring of local governments. The city went through raids by Dutch and Muslim pirates before the arrival of the Spanish and was a horrifying sight of a much bloody battle during the Filipino war and World War II. The monument at the intersection of Quezon and Rizal Streets were built to commemorate the defeat of Filipino fighters by American forces in 1900. In 1941 and 1942, Japanese troops landed and occupied Legaspi City. In 1945, American and Filipino liberation forces supported by Bicolano guerrillas liberated the City from the Japanese.

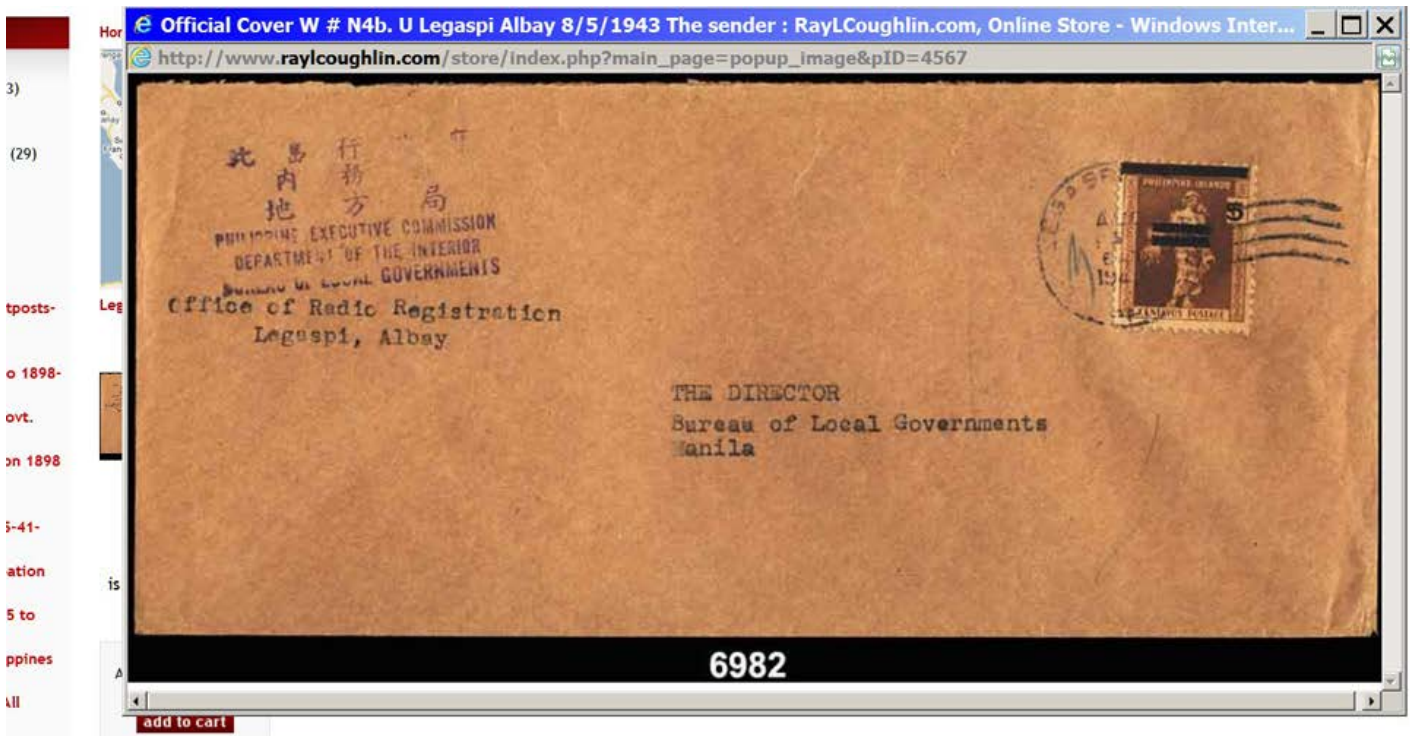
